2019 SA CHAMPIONSHIPS - SOMERSET EAST

This is the first year that our SA Championships was hosted by Somerset East, and the Show committee did more than their best to make the Show a success. Even the weather looked after us. Apart from rain patches for most of Thursday, and cold evenings, the weather was warm and windless for the duration of the Show. It was obvious, on arrival at the showgrounds, that the Show Committee had been hard at work for a long period before the start of the Show. The neatness of the showgrounds was very evident by the clearing of surrounding bush, and the stables were amply supplied with shavings. The lights outside of each stable shone brightly each night which gave the showgrounds a festive feeling. A new collecting ring area was created and cordoned off, which made it easier for entering the arena. The loud speaker system ensured that all the stables knew which class was next, and Chris Bressler did a great job of keeping the show running on time. Pierre Lotter and Ezelle Marais quietly and competently sorted out any sudden unwelcome surprises that reared their heads, which inevitably happen when you least expect them to. Melana Van Aardt kept the office running smoothly, assisted by Adri De Klerk. These two ladies welcomed everyone with a smile which set the tone for a happy show for all to enjoy.



The great surprise for all, especially the campers, was the new ablution block. Apart from toilet and basin facilities, it also offered large shower cubicles which were finished off with hanging and bench space.....a welcome upgrade to the usual show ablutions. These were kept clean and stocked throughout the duration of the Show.

On Thursday night, all of the competitors/stall holders and officials were invited to an evening at the show hall where scrumptious eats were served by Roana Nel & Gill College. Large groups of schoolchildren visited the Show on Friday, who watched some of the horse classes from the stands before being tempted to visit the stalls. Friday evening, the classes went on until well into the dark hours followed by a Round Table steak evening and dance. Competitors were treated to a lunch on Saturday, thanks to the Cookhouse VLV. Saturday mornings are dominated by the Children's Classes, and the Lead Rein is always a delight for all, especially the young competitors. This is evident by the broad smiles on the childrens' faces.



By early Saturday afternoon, spectators began to find their seats around the arena and on the stands. The deck outside of the bar, which is a good vantage point (why else would it be such a popular viewing area?), was filled to capacity for the highlight of the show – the Championship classes. Everything, including the weather, was perfect for the Championships. The announcer, Pierre Jacobs, created an air of excitement when announcing the winners and the music perfectly heralded the winners of each class as they did their victory round. This year, there was a notable increase in new faces and young horses in the showing arena, some of which were introduced to the showing for the first time. There was also an increase in the number of competitors in the Fine Harness, and the 3 Gaited Championship class boasted 11 quality horses.

Congratulations to the Marais family on their stallion, Indiana Hiersek, who was Grand Champion In-Hand, Grand Champion Fine Harness & Grand Champion 3 Gaited. This achievement proves how versatile our horses are.....well done.

For those who have never been to the Uniondale Show, you are missing out on an exciting event. There is a wonderful festival type atmosphere at the show, and plenty to see. The exhibitions of cars and farm implements will delight the men, whilst the various craft and food stalls will enthral the ladies and children. This is one of the few Agricultural Shows that hosts a Budgie Show, which is well worth taking a peek at. There are also sheep, goats and cattle on show.

You can get a great “bird’s eye view” of the arena from the hill which hosts the show hall and the bar, with its spacious deck. Lovely breakfasts and lunches are served in the show hall at affordable prices, and the various food and drink stalls also offer a variety of meals and treats. The arena is bordered with a solid white fence which gives it an enclosed safe feeling to the horses. There are also lovely shady trees dotted around the arena from where the caravaners watch the arena events. The wooden seated stand at the entrance to the arena is always jam-packed for the Saturday afternoon Championships. The local workers cheer for their favourite horses as they enter the arena, and create loads of excitement during each class. It was encouraging to see that some young horses and new riders to the showing, who debuted at Somerset East Show, joined us at Uniondale to add to their experience. Well done to all of you.

The weather was perfect this year, although rather hot at times for the 3 Judges (Kokkies Rademan, Jaco Jonker & Wim Bester) and their stewards (Piet Fouche, Matie Loock & Jan Kritzinger) who braved the two long hot days. The Ringmaster, Lynette Gerber, was very active and vigilant in the arena noticing anything that was out of place. Chris Bressler, once again, kept the show running on time and the competitors on their toes. Oudemeester competed in his first show at Somerset East this year, with Reagan Makwena in the saddle. He really did us proud, achieving 5th place in the 5 Gaited Championship. This was fantastic, as he was a farm horse running around in the mountains with the mares until recently. Replica Fearnot, with Willem Nel, achieved 4th place. This horse is showing a great improvement with each show under the tender care of Willem Nel, and looking more and more like a seasoned showhorse.

SHOWING: PRESENTATION OF HORSE AND RIDER IN 3 GAITED AND 5 GAITED CLASSES

The Cape Boerperd Committee would like to bring the following to the attention of members:

HORSES:

1. Tail: Full, long and pointed. Carried Naturally.
2. Mane: Full, long and trimmed down the neck for approximately 15cm from the poll. No ribbons.
3. No roached manes.
4. Muzzle whiskers, ears and fetlock curls trimmed.

PERDE:

1. STERT: Vol, lank en gepunt. In natuurlike posisie.
2. MAANHARE: Vol en lank, en teen die nek afgeskeer vir ongeveer 15cm vanaf die agterkop. Geen linte.
3. Geen afgeskeurde maanhaar nie.
4. Neushare, ore en kootgewrigte, skoongeskeer.

TACK:

1. BRIDLE: Double bridle in plain, light-weight leather of a rich dark colour. Buckles on bridle should be restricted to key positions, the attachment of reins and cheek-pieces being studded or sewn. All straps to be confined by keepers. Plain or narrow coloured brow-band, not greater than 3,5cm. Rein widths from 1cm to 2cm. Snaffle is wider rein. Plain nose band.
2. BITS – IN STAINLESS STEEL: Cambridge or Portsmouth; Halfmoon Light-Weight used in conjunction with Show bit e.g. plain jointed-mouth light weight Bridoon OR Twisted jointed-mouth light weight Bridoon OR Halfmoon mouth light weight Bridoon; Weymouth bit with port, halfmoon, or plain bar mouth with Weymouth Bridoon; Pelham bit with port, halfmoon or jointed-mouth; Scamperdale Pelham (for horses that fuss with their mouths)
3. SADDLE: Leather or white girth; flat show saddle with full 10cm or modified 7,5 cm cutback head, extra wide flaps cut nearly straight, and square or spoon-type cantle. Minimum seat padding. Stirrup irons fitted with rubber pads.
4. 5 GAITED CLASSES ONLY: Quarterboots, preferably white

TOERUSTING:

1. TOOM: Dubbel toom in effe, liggewig leer of 'n ryk donker kleur. Gespes op die toom moet beperk wees tot sleutelposisies, en teuels of wangstukke moet met sierknoppe/nels aangeheg wees of aangewerk wees. Alle bandjies moet met skutringe vas wees. Effe of smal gekleurede kopband, nie groter as 3,5cm. Teuels is beskikbaar in breedtes van 1 – 2cm. Die trens het 'n breër teuel. Leer neusband.
2. STANG – VAN VLEKVRYE STAAL: Cambridge or Portsmouth; Halfmaan Liggewig gebruik saam met skoutrens e.g. Gewone saamgelaste liggewig trens en toom OF Gevlegte saamgelaste liggewig trens en toom OF Weymouth stang met opening, halfmaan, of gewone stang met Weymouth trens en toom; Pelham stang met opening, halfmaan of saamgevoegde mond; Scamperdale Pelham (vir perde wat met hulle bekke maal)
3. SAAL: Leer of wit bulkgord; plat skousaal met 'n vol 10cm of aangepaste 7,5cm teruggesnyde voorkant, ekstra bree flappe wat amper reguit gesny is met vierkantige of lepelvormige agterboom. Minimum opstospel. Stiebeuels toegerus met rubbers.
4. 5 GANG KLASSE ALLENLIK: Muisskede, verkieslik wit.

RIDER:

1. RIDING HABIT: Kentucky Saddle suit in charcoal or in any dark conservative solid colour. Matching Kentucky jodhpurs with flared cuffs. Waistcoat optional.
2. ACCESSORIES: Soft pastel shirt with collar. Conventional tie. Gloves to match suit in black, brown or navy. Black or brown jodhpur boots. Plain stick with no handle.
3. WOMEN: Bowler hat to tone with colour of riding habit, or black or brown to match jodhpur boots. No jewellery. No dark glasses. Hair neat and controlled in net or bun. Tie pin and small stud earrings permitted.
4. MEN: Felt hat in conservative solid colour to match riding habit. Or Panama or Straw Hat. May wear silk pocket-handkerchief to match tie.

RUITER:

CATEGORIES OF MEMBERSHIP

ORDINARY MEMBER – Any person, owning a registered Boerperd and wants to show in an official Cape Boerperd show, and is 18 years and over – Has voting rights.

JUNIOR LID - Enige persoon onder die ouderdom van 18 jaar – Geen stemreg.

NON-ACTIVE MEMBER - A person who is interested, and might even own a Cape Boerperd, but does not show in an official Cape Boerperd show – No voting rights.

SKOU LID – Persoon wat nie 'n Kaapse Boerperd besit nie, maar wel aan skoue deelneem met 'n Kaapse Boerperd in 'n amptelike Kaapse Boerperd skou – Geen stemreg.

GETTING TO KNOW MORE ABOUT.....

CLYDE PRINGLE

Wow, I am 73 and still blessed to be riding..... and riding in shows.

I grew up on a farm in Ongeluksnek Valley, Matatiele. My first horse was a Shetland pony, called Jackie. The smaller the child, the more reliable he was, except behind his back legs! He only had one eye and disliked any big person trying to ride him. I was 3 years old.



The Basuto's used to ride past our farm gate and they loved tripling horses. The faster the horse, the better. My Dad eventually bought one for me and my love of a tripling horse was born. Our neighbour had a black stallion and he was ridden to the river to drink. He was what I wanted. Years later, I found out that he was from Claude Orpen, Barkley East, and I guess a foal of his famous Fearnot. I was given a mare with SaddleHorse blood who was my schooldays' riding horse.



Many years later I visited Frank Bowker, in Grahamstown, and he took me to see a SaddleHorse stallion Russett Wings. I ended up buying him and, as I was working in Bloemfontein, I decided to ride him at the 1968 SA Champs. This was long before the riding suit was compulsory and I rode in jodhpurs, a jacket, and my father's Sunday hat. He also rode with just co-op plates. He had been 5 gaited Champ at

numerous Eastern Cape shows. As I moved, I had to sell him and the next year he was SA Reserve champion stallion/gelding single harness.

I moved to Rhodesia and started playing polocrosse. When I went back to Natal I played polocrosse and made the Springbok team to tour Rhodesia/Zimbabwe in 1979. It is a fast game, rough and tough. I had a bad accident at practice one Sunday, when my horse fell, and I broke 5 ribs. My doctor who also played said no more playing and tempting fate. So I was able to turn to my first love and purchased the Boerperd, Replica's Reits, a 5 gaited stallion who had been SA Senior Champion and breeding stallion. Life goes on and I reluctantly sold him to Hannes Coetzer in East London, who had more years of successful showing with him. I then purchased Surprise, SA Champion stallion and kept him with George Buys. In a short time I had offers to buy him and, as I was living in Natal, I sold him.

Over the next few years I owned some SaddleHorses but my heart was set on the Boerperd. In 1985 I moved to Komga and was able to think of showing again. I bought a grey 5 gaited mare, Baby Blue, and she was never out of the ribbons. She had amazing speed and endurance. Lee Kaplan saw her and said she was one of the best Boerperd mares she had seen. I also bought a black stallion, Kavalier, a full brother to Knight Rider (Job Steenkamp). With the political turmoil we sold up and moved back to Natal, only to find it was worse there. So, back to East London we came and I was able to show again.

In my desire to improve my horses, I approached Mr Gert Lotter (Snr) and he loaned me a stallion, Paraders Replica, to breed from. He bred me my beloved Bey Event, who in turn bred me Kings Memory, Majuba and Fearnot. At the age of 3 years, Kings Memory was SA Reserve 3 gaited Champion with Reagan in the saddle. He has been 3 gaited Champion at Hofmeyer and Somerset East and has always been placed. Unfortunately, I haven't the mares to do him justice but Colette used him last year and is expecting three foals. Lorrae has his very promising son, Kings Cavalier, out of Colchesters Ninalina.

Over the years I have enjoyed the competition of showing and, at my age, it is truly a blessing that I can still compete. I thank all my fellow breeders for the joy of competing against you and for your friendship. My thanks must also go to my wife, Sheryl, who has supported me through the years.
